Each NZDep decile contains about 10% of small areas in New Zealand. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o Decile 1 represents areas with the least deprived scores</li> <li>o Decile 10 represents areas with the most deprived scores</li> </ul> </li> <li>- It is important to note that NZDep estimates relative socioeconomic deprivation for areas, not people.</li> </ul>
