Professor Goldacre's academic and policy work is in informatics, epidemiology and evidence-based medicine. As Director of the Burnett Institute for Applied Data Science, University of Oxford, he works on various problems, including variation in care, better uses of routinely collected electronic health data, evidence-based social policy, access to clinical trial data, efficient trial design, and retracted papers. Professor Goldacre's books, which include "Bad Science", "Bad Pharma", and "I Think You'll Find It's A Bit More Complicated Than That", have sold over 600,000 copies, and his TED talks have had over 4 million views.
