In July 2024, Roughly one million people were served by unregistered supplies Roughly 78,000 were served from registered, but unverified supplies.
Limitations of data source	The population statistics in the report are estimates derived from the online Water Information New Zealand (WINZ) datasets, and it is not possible to determine their accuracy. Records in the data source may not be current and, therefore, fail to reflect the actual fluoridation status of a given supply at the time of publication.
